Growing our economy and creating jobs

Representative Pam Richardson was instrumental in securing a \$12.9 million earmark for improvements allowing businesses to expand and strengthen Framingham's commercial tax base. The project will bring our community:

- 300 additional **biotech Jobs**
- Hundreds of **construction Jobs**
- **Millions of dollars in new tax revenue** for our schools, public safety and municipal services
- Help to **stabilize the residential property tax burden**

Pam has fought for small businesses that are the backbone of our local economy. She secured monies for Framingham's START Partnership and Downtown Renaissance and has spearheaded the Creative Economy Initiative.

Pam filed legislation and helped create a Task Force to address concerns related to unscrupulous business practices which create unfair competition within our business community.
